How ship-owners are meeting new requirements? Review from the market

Three solutions to meet new requirements:

- Use MGO with sulphur content not higher than 0.1% per mass instead of IFO – currently most common option
- Install scrubbers on board the ship
- Use alternative fuels, e.g. LNG

SCRUBBERS

- The largest, in terms of number of ships, investment in scrubbers have been announced so far by DFDS seaways. DFDS decided to invest EUR 100 million in scrubbers on 21 vessels out of around 45 of its ships.
- The large investment in scrubbers is also being carried out by Finnlines. 14 out of 21 of its vessels are going to use scrubbers. The total investment is estimated at 50 mln EUR, 20.3 mln EUR comes from Finland's initiative to support solutions aimed at combating negative consequences of the 2015 Sulphur Directive.
- By 2015, Scandlines invested 14 million EUR in hybrid propulsion system combined with scrubbers on four of its ships.
- North Sea operator –Brittany Ferries will invest £ 70 million in fitting six vessels with scrubbers

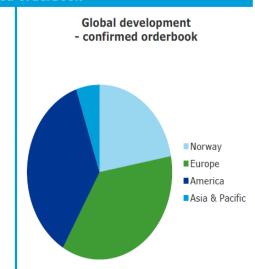

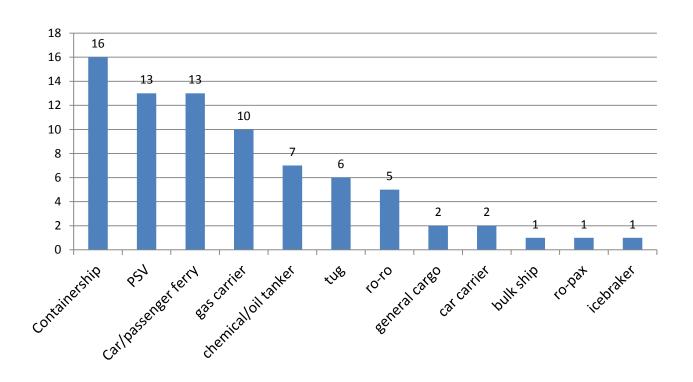

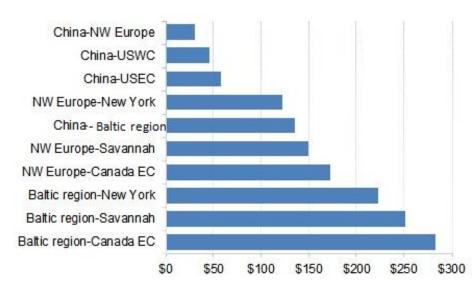

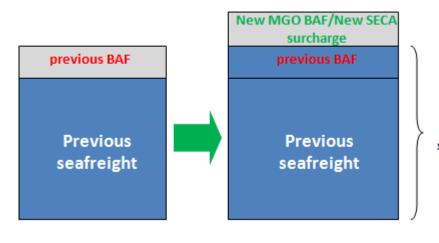
